- without the prior permission of the Chairman of the PESC.
- 2) A Category 6 player will only be eligible to play for a Member Club once the Registration Form has been received by the PESC <u>and</u> duly acknowledged in writing by the Chairman of the PESC.
- The Management Committee reserves the right to check the status and credentials of any registered Category 6 players at any time following registration with the PESC.
- If a Category 6 player is registered with significant errors of information or the Member Club is unable to produce the player's visa or entry stamp, passport or copies of the relevant entries, referred to in a) above, when called upon to do so, they may incur penalties as stated in the TVCL Players Eligibility Rules and Procedures.
